Manufacturers' Index. Manufacturers whose products are described in this edition of PHYSICIANS' DESK REFERENCE are listed alphabetically. Included in this index are the individuals or departments to whom you may address inquiries as well as telephone numbers for emergency calls.

SECTION 1 (PINK) 101

Alphabetical Index. (Part 1 by company name; Part 2 by brand name) This section is an alphabetical index of products by manufacturers (Part 1) and by brand name (Part 2). In Part 1 manufacturers are listed alphabetically with a partial list of their products. In Part 2 products are listed by brand name. The manufacturer's name follows in parentheses. The number following the manufacturer's name refers to the page in PRODUCT INFORMATION (White Section) where the product is described.

SECTION 2 (BLUE) 201

Product Classification Index. Products are listed according to an appropriate category which has been determined by the Publisher in cooperation with each manufacturer. In cases where there were differences of opinion or where the manufacturer had no opinion, the Publisher has made the final decision.

SECTION 3 (YELLOW) 301

Generic and Chemical Name Index. In this section the products described in Product Information (White Section) are listed under generic and chemical name headings according to the principal ingredient(s) of the product. The headings which products are listed under have been determined by the Publisher with the cooperation of the individual manufacturers.

SECTION 4 1-43

Product Identification Section. Over 1,000 capsules and tablets are shown in color and actual size as an aid in identification. Products are shown under company headings, and are not necessarily in alphabetical order since some manufacturers prefer to show their products in certain groups.

SECTION 5 (WHITE) 501

Product Information Section. This section is an alphabetical arrangement by name of manufacturer of over 2,500 pharmaceuticals which are fully described as to composition, action and uses, administration and dosage, contraindications, precautions, side effects, the form in which supplied and other information concerning their use, including their common names, generic compositions or chemical names. See inside back cover for information concerning overdose.

SECTION 6 (GREEN) 2001

Diagnostic Products Information Section. This section is an alphabetical arrangement by name of manufacturer of diagnostic products which are described in such a way as to ease the physician's ability to use them.
